TLC - Teeple's Lawn Care's Charter # : 1316

Teeple's Lawn Care seven application program consists of the following:

Application 1 (Late Winter/Very early Spring) – Complete Fertilizer (slow release-granular)/Grassy annual weed pre-emergent control

Application 2 (Spring) - Fertilizer (slow release liquid)/Grassy weed annual pre-emergent control as necessary / Post broadleaf control

Application 3 (Late Spring /Early Summer) – Micronutrient application with slow release liquid/granular fertilizer to help maintain green color during summer

Application 4 (Late Summer) – Organic summer stress reliever fertilizer (very slow release)

Application 5 (Fall) - Fertilizer (slow release liquid or granular)/ Post broadleaf control as required

Application 6 (Late Fall/Early Winter) - Winter Fertilizer (granular) to help protect grass against winter stresses and promote a quicker spring green-up

Application 7 Lime to maintain proper p.H. level to make sure fertilizers can be efficiently used by the lawn

EXPLANATION OF GARDENS HOA CODING

The following explains the HOA Weed & Feed options coding used on the HOA invoices and how these codes relate with the TLC applications, above:

HOA CODES:

WF3 – The three TLC applications related to the selection of this option are Application 1, Application 2, and Application 5.

WF6 – The six TLC applications related to the selection of this option are Applications 1 through 6.

WF7 – The seven TLC applications related to the selection of this option are Applications 1 through 7.
